You have the opportunity to join others in the Lake of the Woods community to learn a new potential life-saving skill. LOWLINC is sponsoring a workshop, "How to Stop the Bleed" led by the Trauma Team of Mary Washington Healthcare on Saturday morning June 29 from 9-11 am at the Community Center. With excessive bleeding, an injured person could die before help can arrive. You could help save a life by stopping major bleeding. The workshop will include instruction and practice time for basic bleeding control skills that can be used until emergency personnel arrive.
